



FALL MAINTENANCE UNIT STORAGE CHECKLIST

Proper maintenance requires more than just removal from water and placing into dry storage. Follow these steps to help to keep your unit in the best shape for many years to come.

Remove unit from water

Date(s) Removed:

Clean exterior of unit with a soft brush and no-acid cleaner* (if needed)

**This process is easier to perform when the unit is removed from the water but still wet*

Notes on unit condition after removal:

Check and replace sacrificial anode (if needed)

Date(s) Replaced:

Check propeller for any cracks or chips

Notes on propeller condition:

- Examine power cord for any damage
Notes on cord condition:

- Every 3 years of use, have it sent in for seals and oil replacement
Date(s) sent in for replacements:

- Store indoors upside down (prop pointing down)
